## Friday 18 January 2019 - UCI CN Class - Event Guidelines

FIRST WINDOWS & DOORS is proud to present the 2019 BMX New Zealand Championship Nationals. This event will be held at the Te Awamutu Club track. The following guidelines will detail the event & requirement for entry.

### EVENT LOCATION:

Venue - Te Awamutu BMX Club  
Address - Castleton Park, Park Road, Te Awamutu

### ENTRIES CLOSE:

Sunday, 2 December 2018.  
Online entries only. No late entries will be accepted.

### ENTRY FEES:

All entries - \$150.00

### ENTRY INFORMATION:

No entry will be taken on day of event.  
Entry is complete only when payment is confirmed.  
BMXNZ reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.  
No refunds will be given after Thursday 17 January 2019 for any reason. Refund prior to this will be given on receipt of medical certificate, less administration fee of \$20.

### NUMBER PLATES:

Number plates will be issued by event organiser.

### REGISTRATION:

**Championship riders to self register at the following time ONLY.**  
9:00 - 10:00 am - Friday 18 January  
**Registration will NOT be accepted outside of these times**

TRACK IS CLOSED 7.00 am - 10.00 am  
All Classes 10.00 - 12.00 am

### RACING START TIME:

12.30 pm

### RIDERS MEETING:

12.15 pm - Friday

### PRIZE GIVING:

Prize giving will commence onsite approx. 20min after racing

### SEEDING:

Championship riders will be seeded into motos based on their overall UCI ranking.

### MINIMUM CLASS SIZE

6 riders constitute a class.

### RACING FORMAT & MOTO DRAW

UCI Transfer System  
In case of disruption or adverse weather, moto format may be changed, at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire.

### AWARDS & TROPHY ALLOCATION:

Trophies and Presentation Plates to 3<sup>rd</sup> place

### CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS PURSE PAYMENTS:

Purse of \$2000.00 will be proportionally split between classes based on gender equity, number of entries and then pay out to 8th place.  
Payment made in NZD

### TRANSPONDERS:

Transponders will be used at this event .Please update your BMXNZ Online Profile with your transponder number BEFORE the entries close , to see portal follow this link - <https://nzbxm.club/riderportal>  
Transponder Registration. All transponders will need to be registered onsite prior to racing. This will be done at the check point near the Admin hut. This process can be done at anytime during the practice times prior to racing.  
It is the entrants responsibility to check that their transponder is working prior to practice. A non functioning transponder at race time will result in a DNS.

### SCRUTINEERING:

Officials can & will randomly check riders before and during the event, including all official practice and warm up sessions when all rule requirements apply and event number plates must be worn.

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## ONLINE ENTRY PROCESS:

Below is the **BMXNZ** link to the **INDIVIDUAL ONLINE ENTRY** site. All riders wishing to enter the event must **ENTER THEMSELVES**. Supply all detail as requested, check entry detail & confirm entry.

**PAYMENT** will follow the entry process, either via CREDIT CARD or POLi PAY on the site provided online.

Any corrections must be supplied to the entry admin prior to entry close. Changes after entry close will result in a \$50 change fee.

**REGISTRATION** at the event will **ONLY be at the times stated on the flyer**. Riders packs & plates are to be collected & signed for by the rider or a representative of the rider. The responsibility of the packs & plates are on those who collect them.

### BMXNZ CN EVENT HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

BMXNZ, The Waikato Region & Te Awamutu BMX Club will comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 2015 by committing to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all riders, families and visitors to the BMX Event facility. BMX Racing is an action sport & inherently has risks that are accepted as part of sport. All known risks are noted in the BMXNZ Major Meeting RMP & this is available onsite during the event. Parties wanting to assess the RMP prior to entry must contact the club for detail. Entry to this event confirms an understanding of the risks of the sport as noted in the RMP. In the event of injury to an event participant, a completed entry is consent to proper medical treatment being administered. Event entry also consents to submit to drug testing if required. All entrants agree to be bound by the regulations and general conditions for this event as published by BMXNZ in its latest rule book. Any reference to BMXNZ within this flyer or entry is referring to BMX New Zealand Inc.

Safety and safe practices at all BMXNZ calendared events are not negotiable and failure by anyone to comply by the code of conduct or rules of the sport will result in the removal of such person from the event facility.
