CLASSES OFFERED:

Within the competition speciality of BMX Race defined in article 6.1.007 for the Challenge level, the categories are as follows:

20" Boys –ages: 5 and 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16

20" Girls –ages: 5-7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16

20" Men –ages: 17-24,25-29,30-34, 35+

20" Women –ages: 17-24, 25+

CR Boys –ages: 12 and under, 13 and 14, 15 and 16

CR Girls –ages:12 and under, 13 -16

CR Men –ages: 17-24, 25-29, 30 -34, 35 -39, 40 -44, 45-49, 50+

CR Women –ages: 17-29, 30-39, 40+

Masters level, the categories are as follows:

20" Male Masters (aged 30+).

REFUNDS: No refunds will be provided for any reason.

ELIGIBILITY: Riders must have had their 5th birthday before 23/05/2020. Riders must be a citizen of New Zealand

Riders must have entered and competed or provided medical evidence for not competing at the 2020 BMX New Zealand National Championships

3.006 World Championships Qualification

A rider ranked in the top 8 at the BMX NZ National Championships, the year immediately preceding any World Championships, shall qualify for the World Championships, provided the rider has a current licence and has qualified for, entered and competed at the National Championships for the current year.

The remaining qualifying places for any World Championships shall be determined from the current year National Championship rankings, taken in order of finishing position until the total rider entry allocation limit is reached.

Riders who are ranked W1 to W8 at the 2019 Worlds have automatic qualification to the 2020 Worlds.

Riders that did not enter the 2020 National Championships or did not finish in a top 8 position in the 2020 Nationals, may enter as a 'wildcard' entry.

LICENCE REQUIRED: ALL riders must hold a current BMX New Zealand issued Sprocket or Challenge licence, **prior to entering the event.**

- RACE FORMAT:** Standard UCI format under current UCI rules, chapter 6.

- REGISTRATION:** Team Management will advise details of the registration time and location at Houston.
- NUMBER PLATES:** Riders will be provided with number plates.
- RACE JERSEY:** All riders must wear the official BMXNZ 2020 issue race jersey at all practice and race sessions at the Worlds Venue. Riders must order a minimum of 1 race jersey, there is no maximum number that can be ordered.
Race jerseys must be ordered and paid for at time of entry. Please ensure you clearly note the correct size format to be ordered i.e. Youth XS, Women's XS, Men's XS.
- TEAM CLOTHING:** Team Tees and other riders or supporters clothing will be available via the online entry form.
- RACE INSURANCE:** A cover note of the medical insurance policy that covers BMX Racing, which is held or arranged for or by the rider, is to be supplied to BMXNZ prior to 30 April 2020, prior to departure from New Zealand.

- MEDICAL DETAILS:** The online entry form includes a full medical disclosure section, this must be completed in full. This disclosure is for your own benefit. Information is at all times kept confidential & is used by the Team Manager to keep each rider safe and healthy.

- WILD CARD ENTRY:** Application for a wild card entry must be made online to BMX New Zealand prior to the close of wild card entries.
- Complete application for Wild Card entry online
 - Payment to BMX NZ of the Wild Card Entry fee **\$300.00**
 - Offshore riders must supply a copy of passport/birth certificate demonstrating New Zealand citizenship.
 - Upload a document detailing the reason for wild card application and BMX experience of the rider.
 - If not licenced with BMX New Zealand, completion of the licence application and payment of the licence fee is also required with entry.
 - Payment of jersey order.
 - Wild Card applications will only be considered for under subscribed classes.

If a wild card application is not be accepted, a refund of your entry fee, less a \$20.00 administration charge and any bank fees that are applicable, will be made to a supplied bank account after the event.

TRANSPONDERS: Please remove transponders from your bikes prior to departure from New Zealand, these are not needed for this event.
